DONATION GUIDELINES as of 2/1/2022

We respectfully ask that you donate with dignity. Please consider whether you would personally use the items before donating them. If in doubt, throw it out! Donations of clothing and small household items are accepted on Mondays between 10 and 2, excluding holidays. If you have "New with tags" items to donate and cannot come on Monday, please contact Veronica Thomas at 908-354-5456 x403 or via email at vthomas@sjeliz.org.

PLEASE do not leave donations in our parking lot or by the gate.



Clothing – New or gently used and wearable. Please only bring 3 kitchen size (13 gal.) bags at a time due to limited space.

Toys – New or gently used and in working order

Books - one copier paper sized box at a time

Small household items & linens

Flat screen TVs (In working order)

We Do Not Accept



Clothing that is unwearable or dirty

Large children's play items

Furniture and mattresses

Old Textbooks, encyclopedias, or VHS tapes

Old TVs and electronics

Expired or prescription medications

What happens to my donations? We sort donations into new or used. If new, we set it aside for the Giving Tree Holiday Gift program, for community members in need, and for our fundraising tag sales. If used, we make the items available to the community several times a week. Used items that are not given way are bagged for collection by Sentinel Management. We receive a modest donation for the excess clothing. Funds earned from non-food donations are used to operate the center.
